Call for Papers

Centre for East Asian Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University is organizing "The young scholar's sessions on Japan's 'Proactive Contribution to Peace' in the Indo-Pacific Region."

Interested scholars are requested to submit papers following the SAGE journal, International Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University guidelines mentioned below. Selected papers will be invited to make presentation.

The Centre for East Asian Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University, supported by Japan Foundation, is inviting young academic scholars to participate in a research competition organized as "The young scholar's sessions on Japan's 'Proactive Contribution to Peace' in the Indo-Pacific Region."

1. The young scholar session aims to be a research paper competition among young academic scholars across nations.

2. Themes of entries that will be accepted:

Theme I: Japan's 'Proactive Contribution to Peace' in the Indo-Pacific Region: Implication for Regional Security

- Strengthening diplomacy and security and economic cooperation with partners.
- Making an active contribution to international efforts, particularly concerning human security, promoting women's role, the rule of law, and extending overseas development assistance.
- Strengthening domestic foundations and promoting domestic and global understanding.

Theme II : Japan's 'Proactive Contribution to Peace' in Indo-Pacific Region: Promoting International Cooperation

- Strengthening and expanding Japan's capabilities and roles in the Indo-Pacific Region.
- Multilateral initiatives of Japan.
- Strengthening cooperation based on universal values to resolve global issues through initiatives such as the Trans-Pacific Partnership etc.

3. Eligibility : Academic scholars pursuing Graduation/Post-graduation/M.phil/PhD.

4. Instructions:

The paper should be submitted in English within the word limit 5000-8000 words with an abstract of 100-300 words. The submitted paper should be in strict adherence with the SAGE Journal submission guidelines available at <https://journals.sagepub.com/author-instructions/ISQ>.

All papers should be single-authored.

Applications must be sent to the email icpr.ceasjnu@gmail.com; any application sent by other means will not be accepted.

Submission date of papers: 15 January 2021, midnight IST

5. Review of the Papers

The papers submitted on time and in correct format for the young scholar's conference will be blind reviewed by a committee.

6. Awards:

Four papers from each theme will be selected. Out of the eight selected papers, two best papers will be awarded and published.
