Eligibility for the Course

Permanent teachers teaching Japanese language in Central, State and Deemed Universities are eligible to apply. However, being a unique opportunity to learn from the best in the field, ad-hoc and guest teachers as well as JLTTC-A graduates are also eligible to apply.

The priority of filling the seats are as follows:

1. In-service permanent faculties teaching Japanese in central and state universities in India having the qualification as per the UGC norms and guidelines.

2. In-service permanent faculties teaching Japanese in deemed universities in India and having the qualification as per the UGC norms and guidelines.

3. Ad-hoc and guest faculties teaching Japanese in central, state and deemed universities in India.

4. Japanese Language Teachers' Training Course (JLTTC) -A graduates.

Assessment & Certification



All participants shall be assessed keeping in view the learning outcomes of the Refresher Course.



Based on assessment, certificates will be provided under the signatures of the collaborators.



Two types of Certificates shall be issued depending upon the participants.

(i) Those who qualify for the UGC's Refresher Course Programme shall be awarded **Certificate** accordingly.

(ii) The Ad-hoc, Guest faculties and JLTTC-A graduates who attend this Course shall be awarded appropriate **Certificate**.

Boarding and Lodging shall be provided to the outstation participants by the University of Delhi, subject to availability.

Travel Allowance (TA) should be claimed from the parent institution, wherever applicable; where not applicable, will be provided subject to an upper limit.
