

ABOUT JF KOZA

The JF KOZA is a Japanese language course by The Japan Foundation, New Delhi (JFND). In JF KOZA, we use "MARUGOTO". It is designed to enable communication in Japanese in actual situations and to deepen understanding of Japanese culture and Japanese lifestyle by learning about the culture together.

COURSES LEVEL

A1 KATSUDOO & A1 RIKAI **PART 1** (CLASS 1&2)

This course is for complete beginners who are starting Japanese for the first time. You will learn basic expressions, greetings, and simple communication in Japanese.

- Class 1: Offline
- Class 2: Online



A1 KATSUDOO & A1 RIKAI **PART 2** (CLASS 3&4)

This course continues from Part 1 and covers the second half of the A1 level textbook. You will further develop your communication skills and improve your Hiragana and Katakana reading ability.

- Class 3: Offline
- Class 4: Online



A2-1 KATSUDOO & RIKAI (CLASS 5&6)

This course is suitable for learners who already have basic knowledge of Japanese and want to move beyond the beginner level.

You will develop your ability to communicate in a wider range of everyday situations while improving your listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills.

- Class 5: First half
- Class 6: Second half



A2-2 KATSUDOO & RIKAI (CLASS 7&8)

This course is suitable for learners who want to further develop their Japanese communication skills and express themselves more naturally and confidently.

You will learn to handle a wider variety of everyday situations and conversations in Japanese.

- Class 7: First half
- Class 8: Second half



A2/B1 (CLASS 9)



This course is suitable for learners who want to move toward the pre-intermediate level and handle more detailed and complex communication in Japanese.

You will improve your ability to express opinions, describe experiences, and understand longer conversations and texts.

B1 (CLASS 10)



This course is suitable for intermediate learners who want to become more independent users of Japanese.

You will develop the ability to communicate coherently in everyday situations and understand the main points of texts and conversations on familiar topics.
